Meeting Note - A number of people gave late apologies following an earlier accident on the M6.

The following items were raised and discussed.

1. The poor state of the netting at AFC Fylde. Attendees noted that the club had written to AFC Fylde about this matter and awaited a reply.
2. Training over Christmas period was discussed. There was agreement that there would be no training at AFC Fylde during weeks commencing Monday 23rd December and 30th December. (and that training would recommence from Monday 6th January). It was agreed that provided AFC Fylde was open that squads could train during the period if desired. (This should be organised with AFC Fylde directly as presume using different slots, but we will collate who is undertaking for central tracking and accounting purposes).
3. We discussed the league requirement for Respect Barriers on both sides of pitches. We will buy more but note that there is a work around to place a square of cones on the floor to signify a technical area for managers and substitutes.

4. JD highlighted the new “all in one” claim form and explained where it was on the club’s website.
5. The need to complete incident reports was led by MB as the Club’s Welfare Officer. There would shortly be an online version to make completion and submission easier to perform.
6. There was a discussion about what injuries players could play on with – no casts with broken bones should not be allowed. Agreed that it was a subjective area and therefore a parental waiver form would be introduced to provide sufficient cover for the club. Managers should ask parents to complete when there is some doubt as to whether the player is fit to play but the parents insist they can.
7. The new kits from Stanno were discussed – generally seemed that things were ok – using fabric softeners and tumble dryers noted as potentially damaging the materials.
